Public transport is challenged in rural areas


Relatively high costs

Limited service offerings for passengers

Lack of commuter-friendly solutions

Dispersede demand across geography on time





Nærbus is a new solution

Dial-a-ride

Can be found in Rejseplanen (the journey planer)

Same fare system as the regular public transport system

It is possible to subscribe on the same trip


Launched in april 2024








DRT (Flextur)

Municiaplity of Faxe Located 60 kilometers from Copenhagen

Main town: Haslev (12.000 inhabitants)
Previous three routes with limited service

Nærbus covers northern part of Haslev Two Nærbus' are currently operating







Success criteria for local bus



Maintain number of passengers

More satiesfied passengers

User friendly booking service

Stable app and planning engine



The platform – and how to order a trip




Development in number of passengers

165 passengers/day(125 bookings)

800 users per month

5,5 passengers per hour





Other results

81% of all journeys have more than one passenger

8% no-shows

20% late cencelattions

95% punctuallity (3 minutes threshold)

95% books in app

58% thinks Nærbus is better than route buses

Is it feasible to provide school transport through Nærbus rather than conventional fixed-route bus services?



From April 2024 and for the remainder of 2024, Nærbus operated in parallel with the existing local school bus routes.



In the first half of 2025, Movia tested whether Nærbus could serve school children, meaning that pupils and their parents had to make bookings.



It turned out that the booking task was too demanding compared to the flexibility gained. For regular trips, such as school transport, fixed-route solutions are still preferable.

Success criteria for Nærbus- how did it go?



Maintain number of passengers

Number of passengers has been increased slightly

More satiesfied passengers 58% of passengers are more satisfied with Nærbus compared to route busses*

User-friendly booking service
Almost ¾ thinks it is easy to use the app*

Stable app and planning engine
Few or no technical issues during the test period



Long term perspectives

A more attractive public transport choice in rural areas

A supplement to the regular bus service and DRT

Still room to improvement in terms of scaling to scaling
