

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CYCLING IN DENMARK

CHARACTERISTICS



Denmark has approx **5.8 million inhabitants**

Male cyclists count for **47 %** and female for **53 %**

Cycling accounts for **26 % of trips** under 5 km and 16 % of all trips



Trip purpose

Workplace: **33 %**

Education: **11 %**

Errand: **14 %**

Leisure time: **39 %**

Business: **3 %**

On average, **Danes cycle 1.6 km a day**

The citizens of Denmark's three largest cities bike significantly more.

Copenhagen: **3.0 km a day**

Aarhus: **2.5 km a day**

Odense: **2.4 km a day**



**Approximately half of all
Danish children aged 11-15
cycle to school**


**Cycling is not the new normal in Denmark.

But cycling is under pressure from the car.**





Figur 3a: Turfordeling i 2020




Figur 3b: Udvikling i turfordeling 2011-2020 samt mål for 2025
